How to find the scholarship application on Phi Sigma Sigma's secure website:

- Go to www.phisigmastigma.org and click on "Sign In" at the top right.
- Once signed in, hover over "Collegians" or "Alumnae". **Collegians** --> Individual Functions --> Scholarship Application. **Alumnae** --> Get Involved --> Scholarship Application.

The application will populate itself with information about you that is currently available in the Fraternity database. However, throughout the application you are provided the opportunity to add/update your information. The more you add/update the more points you will receive.

You are also able to return to your application and make changes up until the final deadline. That means you may return to the application as often as you need to AFTER you submit. In addition, you are able to submit your application and later upload forms like your recommendation or other documents as long as they are uploaded by the application deadline.

The Foundation will automatically consider your application for all of the scholarships for which you are qualified. We will ONLY consider you for educational grants if you complete the financial aid sections of the application.

Information regarding available educational grants, scholarships, and Chapter Educational Funds may be found [here](#). Applicants no longer need to specify which scholarships they are applying for. All applications will be screened for eligibility for all scholarships.

Take care to follow all directions and comply with all requirements.

In order for your application to be considered, all of the following must be submitted **by April 8, 2022**. **Late materials** will not be considered, and **extensions** will not be granted. To assist you, fill in the date that each requirement was uploaded after receiving them from the appropriate sources.
